Good news from GreenfieldCities. In the past months, we have worked hard on the Midterm results of the feasibility study for a clean-tech business campus in Mafraq, Jordan. Our lead architect worked with Jordan student teams on the sketch design of the campus. Our Jordan team has vetted the support and feasibility of our campus plans in Mafraq. Preliminary conclusions are positive.

On November 18th, we organize a workshop in Amman with public and private sector representatives from Jordan, the Netherlands and the EU to explore and define next steps. These consist amongst others of a more in-depth feasibility study, permitting activities, and closing partnership agreements for the six focus sectors on the Campus (ICT, Energy, Water, Agri-Food, Built Environment, and Hospitality).

On the Sustainable Development Goals Action day in Amsterdam we already presented some preliminary outcomes for these sectors, presenting them as international business opportunities.
