Exciting news from GreenfieldCities. Just before the summer break, we finalized the feasibility study for the Youth Business Campus in Mafraq, Jordan. The Youth Business Campus is a safe and sustainable place where talented Jordanian and Syrian youths can live, learn and work inside their own home region. The study results for this pilot project to reduce forced migration to Europe demonstrate convincingly that humane solutions in regions of origin are feasible, practical and scalable.

Triodos Foundation has become our first (financial) friend and has helped improve the quality of the study. Friends like Triodos help to create a much-needed financial basis for GreenfieldCities to invest in a greener, more stable and safe world for everybody.

With the strong study results in hand, we should be able to raise the funds for our next step. Within two years, we want to develop and build the Pop-up stage of the campus for 250 young Jordanians and young Syrian refugees. To bring the Youth Business Campus model even more to life for authorities and (impact) investors, we will start by building an Information and Exposition Center on the campus grounds. This center will also serve as a podium for the small but thriving artist community in Mafraq.


